The said Sheriff General Assembly taking in conde-
-ration that by reason of the sitting of the House
it should be impossible for the several Sheriffs of the province
to make demand of the public due and officers fees by
the laws appointed in the aforesaid act -

Be it therefore enacted by the authority
advice and consent aforesaid, that for this present year
the several Sheriffs within this province shall have
liberty for and within the first day of March next to
demand the public due and no longer, that if the same
be demanded by that time it shall be lawful for them to
execute for the same according to the tenor of the said
enacted Act, and that if any person shall be taken
or before the first day of March next he or she do
the Sheriff of his intention to make due of the same
due to such edit or the Sheriff shall be obliged to pay
the same that if any person whatsoever will pay any
in the name of Tobacco for their duty by the said first day
of March next the Sheriff shall be obliged to take receipt
to pay the same according to the direction of the said enacted
Act anything in this act or any other act Statute or
Custom to the contrary notwithstanding -
