

*Act of Assembly of the Province of New-Jersey
Enacted in 1715 - This was
Repealed -*

An Act for continuing what Damages
be allowed upon protested Bills of Exchange.

Be it Enacted by His Excellency most Excellent May by Queen
the advice & consent of the Majt^t of Government Council and Assembly
of this Province and the authority of the said Majt^t that
allowed and paid to any person or persons wh^tsoever having
cause to ask Demand & recovery of or implead any person or persons
whatsoever living or residing in this province upon any Bill of Ex-
change drawn after the end of this Session of Assembly any sum or sums
of money what so ever payable in any part of Europe or the West
Indies & brought in here protested the sum of ten pounds & Cent
Damages over and above the sum of money for which such Bills shall
be drawn with the allowance of three Shillings and six pence for the
protest and no more any Law Statute Usage or Custom or other Contrary
thereto notwithstanding -

And be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid that
if any person or persons after the end of this Session of Assembly draw
Bills of Exchange upon any person or persons Society or Company
in Europe or the West Indies and the same be protested and the
protested Bills be returned into the province within five years
after the date of such Bills shall then the Deb^t Recalled by the
non acceptance or non payment of such Bills shall be accounted a
Debt of equal nature with any specially and shall and may be
Recovered by action of Deb^t in any Court of Record of this province
without alldging the custom of Merchants or the Declara-
tion of the drawer or Indorser thereto and shall be accounted
a debt due from the drawer or Indorser for the sum of
such Bills of Exchange their Executors or administrators
Provided the same be first legally demanded of such drawer or
Indorser their Executors or administrators any Law off^t year
Custom or the contrary notwithstanding -
