Act of Assembly of this province intituled an act for encouragement of Tillage & Reliefe of poor Debtors made at an Assembly begun & held at the port of Annapolis the fifth day of September 1708. But enacted by the Queen most Excellent maj^{ty} by and with the advice and Consent of her maj^{ty}'s Governour Councils and Assembly of this province of the Authority of the said that the above mentioned act intituled an act for encouragement of Tillage & reliefe of poor debtors be and there by revived & continued in full force and strength from the present Session of Assembly for and during three years to the end of the next Session of Assembly which shall first happen after the said three years.
