But Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Maj: by and with the advice and Consent of her Maj:ys Governor Council and Assembly of this Province & the Authority of the same that the above mentioned act Entituled an act for Encouragement of Villages & relief of poor debtors and whereby revived & Continued in full force and Strength from ye
present Session of Assembly for and during three years to the end of the next Session of Assembly which shall first happen after the said three years.
