An Act for relief of Tobias Pollard and John Pollard of Dorchester County

General Assembly

Whereas Tobias Pollard Second Son of John Pollard late of Dorchester County deceased  
and John Pollard Grandson and Heire at Law to the said John Pollard Esquire  
petitioned this Generall Assembly that the aforesaid John Pollard Esquire his last  
will and Testament had devised to a certaine Wm Pollard deceased father of the Petitioners  
John Pollard severall Tracts of Land viz<sup>r</sup> Winfields point Tobias &t the Bear Grass  
Reeden, Hamersmith, Patrick Wells, and Williams Goodwill And to the said Tobias  
Pollard divers other Tracts of Land Viz<sup>r</sup> Marshland Sharpes out lett, Sharpes desire  
Blood point John deshie the Raw, Island in the Marsh Woolf Trapp Ridge, Goation an  
good Luck point, And the heires Males of their Bodys lawfully begot shall which  
said Tracts of Lands lying and being in Dorchester County aforesaid Children of the  
said Tobias Pollard being daughters, are not Capable of Inheriting by reason of the  
Speciall Tayle aforesaid, and the said John Pollard being deceased and not left  
of ever having any heire, the said Tobias and John Pollard therefore humbly prayed  
this Generall Assembly would give Leav to bring in a Bill for their Relief by dividing  
in their Estates into a Tayle. Generall

Be it therefore Enacted by the Queen most Excellent Maj: by and with the  
advice and Consent of her maj: Council and Assembly of this province and the  
Authority of the same that the said John Pollard the Grandson and Tobias Pollard the  
Younger Son of the said John Pollard Esquire deceased each and either of them shall  
the Authority of this Generall Assembly and by Virtue of this act severally have  
held and Enjoy and to all intents and purposes whatsoever be deemed and adjudged to  
hold Enjoy and be severally posset of the severall Tracts of Land and Tenements as by  
said will devised and have Estate therein in Tayle Generall any Law Statute Usage or  
Custome or any Article or Clause in the said will to the contrary notwithstanding
