revised. Be it Enacted by the Queen in her Excellency by and the advice and consent
of the Council and Assembly of this province and the authority of the same
that an act of Assembly made at a Generall Assembly of this province begin-
ning at the 19th of June 1700 to be yearly for the year of our Lord one thousand
and seven hundred and seven yeare thereafter an act for killing holt
cows and every article thereof being therein contained and is hereby renewed
Continued in full force and direction and after the end of this present Session
of Assembly for and during the space of three years and to the end of the next Session
of Assembly in which it shall be first presented to the said Assembly
