Oppor and to whom house of this Assembly that it shall be following many ones that shall be necessary to any Appointee servant that shall leave or course of himself or departe away out of the said Province do avantage shall doubtless the tyme of such his or her unlawfull departure and absence to his or her said master or dame over and above other damages and costes to be aduertised by the Just prooves shall be made & done one that shall transport any his or her servant out of this Province shall pay double costes and damages to the partie grieved for such servant to abouer price absente in service to his or her master or dame in devery, his or her servant or Appointee that shall absent himselfe out of the service of his or her master or dame and during the tyme of such absence in service to his or her master or dame shalbe no Inhabitant in this Province that shall willingly harbor or entortayne such servant or Appointee or shall for redemeing bee pined or confuted as the Governor and Counsell their present or other Judge shall think fit And every person and persones that shall transport or carry out of this Province that is or shall be indebted on me goods herein shall be liable to satisfy all such debts foyagements and damages to the person or persons to whom the same shall be satisfied in convenient tyme or that in short tyme he can so procure such person to return again unto this Province whereby he may be tyed to justice here

the Indians and the inhabitants of this Province. Be it enacted by the Lord Proprietor by the advice and assent of the upper and lower house of this Assembly, That any Indian or Indians  
out of this Province and shall be disposed of any French Indian or Indian what so ever or endeavour or attempt so to do without licence from the Governor for the time being and all  
any of their estates howbeit any one informing or causing such offender or offenders to be apprehended shall have such satisfaction for his wages and diligence therein out of this sum  
am to be paid him. And it is further enacted by the authority aforesaid that no inhabitant of this Province shall deliver any Gun or Gunnes or Ammunition or other kind of martiall Ordnance  
ammunition or to any other person without <sup>the</sup> ~~Lord Proprietor or~~ <sup>the</sup> licence from the Governor for the time being upon paine of forfeiture to the Lord Proprietor one thousand pounds of the value  
thereof or take the same from such Indian or informer make proofe thereof Andrew Buzanazimuth beinge now present to M<sup>r</sup> Penn who is hereby appointed to see to the execution of this Law.

**H**AN HCT for takinge an oath offidely to the roade of proprieete

for taking an oath of fidelity to the lord Proprietor.  
be contented that the people and persons within this Assembly that are by reason from time to time inhabiting or residing within this Province and such who have or shall from time to time  
take the oath hereunder mentioned in this Act and administer the oath of fidelity to the lord Proprietor of this Province to be administered unto him and them respectively  
of this Province for the time being or by such person or persons as he or the lord Proprietor of this Province or his heirs or executors and proprietaries of the same shall be  
so forth said. And if any person or persons whatsoever shall be in this Province [at] any time within the same refuse to take the said oath upon the same  
this Act wherein it is above set forth to administer unto him or them respectively for refusing said oath after such refusal being published without  
leave from the lord Proprietor or his heirs or executors and proprietaries of this Province or his or their Lieutenant or chief Governor of the same for that purpose  
such refusal as aforesaid shall be found in any parts of this said Province thirty days after such refusal or shall afterwards return into any part of this said Province without  
any cause again refusing to take the said oath upon the said day, then and there according to the true intent and meaning of this Act which it shall again be at any time before  
the said Lieutenant or chief Governor of this Province or his heirs or executors and proprietaries of this Province shall then  
then and there Lieutenant or chief Governor and [the] Council of this Province for that time being in the major part of them which shall be determined by the Lieutenant or chief Governor or his  
or all manner one and to have a negative voice [at] thine [the] time fit and the Hals and either or both intended by this Act is as followeth.

The Chath off ffitility to the Lord Proprietor of this Province  
for long as I shall be a member of this Province to the right hono: Charles Lord Baron of Baste more Lord Proprietor of this Province of Maryland and the Islands therunto belonginge and to the  
said Lieutenant or chiffe Governor here for the time beinge I will not att any tyme by word or action in publicke or private writing, or writing, and may derogate from but will att all  
my power defend and maintaine all such his fau: & to his heire or issue, and lawfull heire, his interest, privilege, fueldiccion, & rogetie propriety, dominion over and in the said Province  
who ever shall be there in for the tyme beinge as are granted to his fau: & to his heire by the late Kinge of Englands in his fau: & by patent of the said Province under the Great Seal of England,  
by reason of Conseruo in poole of Religion & I doe alsoe declare that I will w<sup>t</sup> affayled to his fau: & to his Lieutenant or other chiffe Governor of the said Province for the tyme  
of the said conspiracy for Combinacon w<sup>t</sup> I shall knowe or have my selfe cause to suspect id or shall bee intinded agaist the person of his fau: & to his heire or issue, and any waies to the disuersion or depriva-  
tion, dominion aforesaid or any part thereof, and I doe swear that I will not either by my selfe or by any other person or persons directly, or indirectly take, receive, purchase or posses  
of the Province of Maryland or the Islands therunto belonginge from any Indian or Indians to any other rfe or rfs but to the rfe of his fau: & to his heire or issue Proprietaries of the  
said Province, not deriving a legall title thereto by, from, or under said Indians from his fau: & to his heire or issue and Proprietaries of this Province legally passed, or to bee passed, under his or their  
beinge, for helpe and succor //

Yn Act concerninge Acomptance to the Lord Proprietary

and to the assent & approbation of the upper and lower house of this Assembly that all and every person or persons who shall hereafter at any time make any account or accounts or any entry  
or chandis or what so ever to or for the use of the Lord Proprietary or his house unto or to his or their Secretary of this Province for the time being or unto any other officer or Minister  
unto whom appropriated or to be appropriated to receive or take such account or accounts shall not make or deliver a true and just account or entry of or for any such  
faids but shall conceal the same unto person or persons after proof thereof made shall forfeit to the Lord Proprietary and his heirs all such money goods chattels Comodities or  
any or either shall not be made and be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid that all and every person or persons in this Province who have shall or may be intituled  
to the fide Lord Proprietary or his heirs shall take his Dowerall that upon the half yearly to be administered by the Secretary or other officer of the  
Province to them by virtue of this Act to administer the same if they think fit that all such Accounts and
