An Act concerninge Accountants to the Lord Proprietary

the assents approbation of the upper and lower house of this Assembly That all and every person or persons who shall hereafter at any tyme make any account or accounts or any entry
or entries whatsoever to or for the use of the Lord Proprietary or his heirs unto or wth his or thiers Secretary of this Province for the tyme beinge or unto any other Officer or Minister
of this Province appointed or to be appointed to receive or take such Account or to make such entry And shall not make or deliver a true and just account or entry of or for any such
entry but shall contrarie the same such person or persons after proofe thereof made shall forfeit to the Lord Proprietary and his heirs all such money goods chattells Commodities or
other things that shall be made And be further enacted by the authority aforesaid that all and every person or persons wth in this Province who have or may be intrusted
wth the said Lord Proprietary or his heirs shall take his or thiers Oath vpon the holy Evangelists to be administered by the Secretary or other officer therunto appointed
in tyme to tyme by virtue of this Act to administer for the same as they thinkes fitt that all such Accounts or entries for any such money goods chattells or other merchandises

upper and lower house of this Assembly that from hence forward every Inhabitant of this Province shall have free liberty to trade wth any Indian or Indians wth in this Province
or to trade or other passage through any parte of this Province to trade for the like Commodities wth any Indian or Indians wth out this Province and to export the same
Commodities as hee or shee shall not be exported out of this Province without speciall leave for the same to be obtained from tyme to tyme from the Lieutenant or thiers Governour
of this Province or the Lord Proprietary or his heirs dords and Proprietaries of this Province shall from tyme to tyme appointe payinge a duty in weight or value for all the
Commodities of this Province. Provided that no person or persons who shall at any tyme hereafter trade as aforesaid doe sell any Armes or ammunition to any Indian
or Indians wth or give any assistance or offence to any Indian or Indians for tradinge wth them or their wherby the publique peace or safety of this Province maye be endangered by any
offence done by any of them to any of the Inhabitants or people of or in this Province and provided also that no person or persons who shall for trade as aforesaid doe have the private
trade of the Inhabitants and people of and in this Province nor goe forth vpon any such Ordnance or Ordnance in strength either in men or Armes or ammunition wherby those Indians
maye be destroyed or doe them mischief for the better prevention of all which It is all be enacted by the authority and wth the assent aforesaid that all every person
from tyme to tyme have the liberty of the said Lieutenant or thiers Governour of the Province for the tyme beinge or of such Officer or Officers as hee or shee or the Lord Proprietary
or thiers Governour or other Officer or Officers aforesaid that they and every of them respectively will observe and comply wth all and every of the provisions abovesaid wth out
excuse or delay whatsoever shall trade wth any Indian or Indians either in or through any parte of this Province any thinge in this Act to the contrary in any
person or persons from tyme to tyme not beinge Inhabitants of this Province shall be permitted vpon any tyme or whatsoever to trade wth any Indian or Indians in
or to be from tyme to tyme obligated for the same from the Lord and Proprietary of this Province or his heirs vnder his or thiers hand and Seale all Armes or his
Commodities beinge vnder the Great Seale of the Province vpon payme of confiscation to the Lord Proprietary and his heirs of all goods and Commodities carried and
taken in or by any such trade or Commerce in case they cannot be seized in specie then in the value thereof of which any such offence against this Act and the true Intention
when the person or persons for offendinge or any of his or thiers money goods or chattells shall be apprehended or seized on in any parte of this Province
