To the end his Majesty the better perceive our good will and intentions in complying with his Majesty for far as our poore and late distracted condition can be encouraged and enabled to direct us in our lives liberties and estates. Be it enacted by the Lord Proprietary with the advice and consent of the Council that no man be bound for any other Point than his Majesty's. He shall pay for a Custom to the Lord Proprietary of this Province and his heirs for these seven years only a quantity of a hog's head (except to be transported out of the Province) And any one transporting or attempting to transport any Tobacco chargeable the Governor or other Officer authorized in that behalf shall forfeit in kind if it may be satisfied or else in value all the Tobacco so attempted to be transported. And the same shall be employed towards the satisfaction of all just arrears and claims touching the late records and defences of the Province do have been before the last day of March One thousand six hundred forty and seven until they be fully discharged.

*Act* for the support of the Lord Proprietary

Be it enacted by the Lord Proprietary with the advice and assent of the upper and lower house of this assembly that whosoever shall steal or wrong double the value of such Cattle to the true Owner thereof and two hundred pounds of Tobacco more to him that shall inform thereof and three hundred pounds out of every such Offender's estate or goods. And in case any one offending herein shall not be found able to satisfy for such offence as aforesaid then present in Court or other Judge shall think fit. And whosoever shall know of any such hog or hoggs stolen and shall not reveal the same forthwith as the cause Offender aforesaid. And every one that shall kill any unmarked Cattle of above three months old (except upon his own lands) shall pay a hundred pounds of Tobacco to him that shall inform and make proof thereof over and above two hundred pounds of Tobacco for a fine. And all the Inhabitants of this Province are required by virtue of this Act to bring in their several marks of hoggs and other Cattle and to the Governor and Council then present shall think fit.
