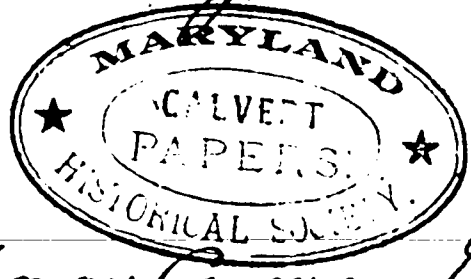


An Act Repealing all former Acts of Assembly heretofore made
Saving what are hereby Excepted

Be it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and
consent of her majestys Governor, Council and Assembly of this Province, and the authority of
the same, that all and every Act and Acts of Assembly of this Province made or Enacted at
any time before the Session of Assembly begun and held at the Port of Annapolis, the
Twenty sixth day of April 1704, Except the Act Entituled, an Act for the Establishment
of Religious Worship within this Province according to the Church of England, and for the
Maintenance of Ministers and except the Act for keeping good Rules and orders in
the Port of Annapolis, in which we are not revised, should and should be Repealed
Assembly, be and are hereby repealed and made void: Saving always to all and every
Person and Persons whatsoever was and is, his or their rights and Benefits, which they
had by the former Acts of Assembly: any thing in this Present Act contained to the
contrary, Notwithstanding
