

And be it further Enacted by the authority  
aforesaid by and with the advice and Consent aforesaid. that the said  
Duty and Imposition shall be from time to time paid and Satisfied by  
the Master and Masters of every such Ship or Vessel respectively  
in which any such Tobacco shall be Exported upon his or their (Clearing)  
and taking out of his and their Dispatch and dispatches for every  
such Ship and Vessel and before the Departure of such Ship or Vessel  
from this Province. And that all and every Master and Masters  
of any Ship or Vessel coming into this Province shall at their first  
Arrivals here and before their Loading on board any goods or Commodi-  
ties of the Growth, Production or Manufacture of this Province give  
good and sufficient Security and Securities to the Lord and Proprietor  
to the Lieut. Generall or chief Governour of this Province for the  
time being for the true payment of the said Duty and Imposition  
accordingly.

And be it further Enacted by the authority  
of and by and with the advice and Consent of that all and every person  
and persons Shipping or Loading on Board or attempting or Endeavour-  
ing to Ship or Load on Board in any Ship or Vessel whatsoever any  
Tobacco for which the said Duty or Imposition is or shall be due before  
such Security given by the Master or Masters of such Ship or Vessel for  
the payment and Imposition before mentioned and a Certificate of  
such Security given first had and obtained under the hand and Seal of  
the Lord and Proprietor or Lieut. Generall or chief Governour of this Prov-  
ince for the time being, or of such officer or officers on that Behalf for  
the time being to be appointed shall forfeit the same or the Value thereof  
the one moiety whereof shall be to his said Lordship his heirs and  
Successors Lords and Proprietors of this Province and the other moiety to  
him or them who shall sue or sue for the same by Bill Plaint or  
Information in any the Courts of Record within this Province  
provided always that the one half of the money by this Act  
to be raised be employed towards the maintaining a constant  
Magazine with Armes and Ammunition for the defence of this  
Province and defraying of the publick and necessary Charges of the  
Government. Provided also that so long as this Act shall  
continue no publick Levy shall be laid upon the Freemen and  
Inhabitants of this Province but by Consent of the said Freemen in open  
Assembly first had and Obtained, and that during the Continuance  
of this Act as of the last Clause of an Act Entituled an Act concern-  
ing Levying War within this Province (by which Clause it is  
Enacted that all Charges arising from time to time by defence  
of the Province against any Invasions of any Enemy or Enemies
