 the foregoing Coures in the said Act remaining still in full  
 force and Virtue. — Provided likewise that so long as this Act  
 shall Continue his sd Lordship his Receiver or Receivers Generall  
 for the time being shall Receive good, sound and merchantable Tobacco  
 when Tended for his said Lordships Rents or fines for alienation  
 of Lands reserved upon the severall and respective Grants of Lands  
 in this Province at the Rate of Two Pence of Pound, any thing in his  
 said Lordships Grants to the contrary hereof Notwithstanding  
 Provided also and it is hereby Enacted by the right Honble  
 the Lord Propriety by and with the Consent of the upper and lower  
 Houses of this present generall Assembly, that the Act Entituled an  
 Act for the Muster, Muster Generalls fees be and forever henceforth  
 stand Repealed, This Act to Continue during the naturall life of  
 the right Honble scilius now Lord and Propriety of this Province  
 and for one Cropp more next after his decease and no longer

 Charles Calvert Esq: Capt: Gener: of Maryland.

Whereas by an Act made at a Generall Assembly held at  
 the City of Saint Maries the 27<sup>th</sup> Day of March in the 35<sup>th</sup> year of  
 his Lordships Dominion over this Province Annoq: Dom: 1671  
 Entituled an Act for the Raising and providing a Support for his  
 Lordship the Lord and Proprietary of this Province during his  
 Naturall life and likewise a Supply towards the defraying the  
 publick Charges of Government, it was Enacted that from and after  
 the first Day of September then next coming there should be raised  
 Levied Collected and paid unto your Lordships your Heirs & Successors  
 Lords and Propriety of this Province the Sum of Two Shilling Sterling  
 for every Hoghead and quantity of a hoghead of Tobacco which  
 should be at any time then after shipped in any Ship or Vessel  
 to be Exported out of this Province or any the Territories Islands  
 Ports, Rivers, Creeks or places thereunto belonging and it was
