Whosoever English Servant Run away in Company
with Negroes or other Slaves who are incapable of
making Satisfaction by the Oath of their Bond
Enacted by the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietor
by the consent of the Hon^{ble} Lords of the
of this Court Generall Assembly that any
English Servant or Servants that shall Run away
in the Company of any Negroes or other Slaves
shall be liable to pay either singly or proportionally
if more than one all such Just Damages to the
Owners or Masters of the same as shall be made
appear before any Courts of Record in this Province
