

Her Majesty of this Province has therefore granted by
this said Proprietary by writing that pursuant of the
London house of the said present General Assembly
what person or persons shall export or ship on
board to the intent to export or ship on board to
intent to export out of the country either wool or
Iron shall for every of them offenders in so doing pay
as follows to wit for every pound of Wool fifty pounds
of the same for every pound of Iron ten pounds of the
same half of the said payment for feitors shall be
paid to the Informer the other half to the Lord Proprietary
And this Act to continue three years or
to the end of the next General Assembly

not being in Capacity to pay for the same the said Act
