

It is further Enacted that the Surveyor General or his Deputy
 shall keep a book of all the Surveys that they shall
 make within the Province respectively in the said
 books if kept by his Deputy shall be yearly returned
 to the Surveyor General or in case the Surveyor General
 or his Deputy shall neglect to keep such books or
 cause to where by any loss or within this Province
 shall suffer damage by the loss of his land surveyed
 or otherwise Do it further Enacted that the said
 Surveyor General or his Deputy in whom the
 default shall be found to be shall be liable to satisfy
 all such damages as shall be adjudged him in the
 Provincial Court only the said damages shall
 be tried, And for the adding of all Controversies
 the Surveyor to the People of the Province Do it
 Enacted that the Surveyor shall be for his demands
 his fees be bound to deliver the list of Surveys to the
 parties for whom he surveyed the land And that
 the said list shall deliver the list into the Office
 And this Act to endure for three years or to the
 end of the next General Assembly —
