The Bonds for of this Assembly (upon a postⁿ p[ro]posed
by the Mayor & Master of the Merchants of Baltimore
County) Considering the inability of Baltimore
County to defend it selfe by reason of the few inhab-
itants therin And yor commandes p[ro]posing
refusing money & great tracts of land whereby the same
would come to waste & downe are minded there being no
land to take up, And what is already taken yor not
be purchased but all doers rates whereby the County
is in no probability (of a long time) to be able to defend
it selfe as their owners, And itt therefore Resolved
by the Lord Prop. by ex parte the consent of the upper
& lower house of this yor Govt General Assembly that
all persons who have land lying or being in Baltimore
County in the Province of Maryland shall att or before
the 25th Day of December: 1664. seathe the same, And
if such persons as aforesd do not seathe their respective
parts of lands then itt shall be law for any one
who hath aduise so live in Baltimore County to
take up any such seathe of land (not seated as
aforesd) as to seathe thereon as if itt never had
been taken up or partitioned, Itt willd that
whoever shall take up such land as aforesaid
shall seathe the same with three abe-
