

And whereas the said John the first King of England the said  
25th day of December 1604 ordered the said land  
to revert to the first Owner thereof without any  
further charge if the aforesaid Owner doth not  
lease the said land as aforesaid within two months  
next ensuing the term of Possession of both lands unto  
such Owner as aforesaid then it shall be lawful  
for any owner to do as he shall see cause to take it up as  
if it never had been taken up & patented  
Provided he lease it within two months next after  
the lapse of the first Owner thereof if it be not  
leased within two months as aforesaid then to  
revert to the first Owner as aforesaid  
I would that this Act nor any thing therein  
contained do not extend to release any Person or  
Persons who hath forfeited his or their lands by the  
Act for aforesaid Plantations or to any other Person  
under Act
