all Slaves of what age or sex what free
& other of some imported into this Province
above the age of ten years have been m^ol^d
ed in the Custom Act for the said Province
of an Act made at St. Marys the first of April
1662 concerning taxable persons which makes
no provision for such as ought to be taxable
to the Master Master Generall Brit^{ain} therefore
