

To the Inhabitants of this province at Exeter
held on Exeter the 18th Commodities to the
great Loss Damage and Detriment of the
Inhabitants of this Province Be it therefore
enacted by the Right honorable the Lord Bishops
by & with the Advice & assent of the upper
Chamber house of this present year assembly
that no person or persons for Trading or for
to into this province shall by & sell or carry
or transport any such goods imported by ship
& other Navigation only excepted upon the
penalty of forfeiting all such Goods or the value
thereof the one half to the Lord Bishop the
other half to the Inhabitant to be recovered
in any Court of Record within this Province
by Bill plaint or Information when and
where no protestation or way of Law to be
allowed & that it to endure for three years
or to the end of the next year assembly
