of the Courts in the County of

Whereas divers of the inhabitants of this province
have been much burthened by the small expenses
of all parts of the respective Courts within this pro-
vince for the prosecution whereof for many years past
therefore enacted by the Right honorable the Lord Proprietor
by & with the consent of the Upper & lower house of
this present general assembly that from and after
the publication of this act no Clerk of any County Court
whatsoever within this province shall exact any other
fee than is here prescribed vizt) for the entering any
matter upon Record not exceeding half a bushel in the
Record books being in folio eight pounds of tobacco, if
matter entered upon Record be above half a bushel of a
bushel in folio six shillings of tobacco (for the copy of
the Record) And for every side of a bushel in folio
eighteen pounds of tobacco for the copy of the
Record the same fees as foregoing for any
writ warrant or license or certificate fifteen
pounds of tobacco if a warrant or license or
certificate be for more than one thousand
fifteen pounds of tobacco except for jurors
only, for drawing any matter to be put up
