

of debts & deterring of Riches & persons who contract  
debts out of a confidence of an impunity of their persons,  
Be it also enacted that whosoever which shall be taken  
in Execution from after the 23<sup>rd</sup> of April 1664 for  
any debt or damage awarded in any Court of this  
Kingdom shall not within eight days after his said  
being taken in Execution satisfy the party or parties  
at whose suit he was taken in Execution shall by the  
Respective Sheriffs of the severall Counties be brought  
down to the Prison at St. Marys & delivered to the  
Keeper of y<sup>e</sup> said Prison for y<sup>e</sup> tyme being, who  
from that tyme of his delivery shall have all such  
fines allowed him for Imprisonment of such offend-  
ers respectively as the Sheriffs of y<sup>e</sup> severall Counties  
hitherto have had & enjoyed or shall hereafter be  
limited & appointed to such Sheriffs, Provided always  
that if any other County will be at the charge of a  
Prison within their own County for y<sup>e</sup> Effectual rest-  
raint of Debtors the Prisoners of such County for  
anything not concerning life or Member shall not be  
brought to the prison at St. Marys anything in this  
law to y<sup>e</sup> contrary notwithstanding lastly for the  
greater security of Gods and hono<sup>r</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> Lordship  
in y<sup>e</sup> due Execution of his said Beite enacted by y<sup>e</sup>  
authority & Consent aforesaid that as well the sayd  
Staplefort as all other Keepers hereafter of  
prisons to be erected shall give y<sup>e</sup> Governo<sup>r</sup> of  
France security for y<sup>e</sup> well & safe keeping of all  
prisoners committed to their charge And be it fur-  
ther enacted that if y<sup>e</sup> St. Raymond Staplefort or  
some other person whom y<sup>e</sup> Lieutenant Governo<sup>r</sup> shall  
think fit to inhabit within y<sup>e</sup> building of a  
prison doe not some tyme before the tenth day of  
August next give in security to y<sup>e</sup> Lieutenant Governo<sup>r</sup>
