enacted by every Mayor, Minister or Justice assign

view of y<sup>e</sup> sort And if any Mayor or sort aforesaid  
shall be aggrieved with y<sup>e</sup> determination of y<sup>e</sup> Court  
he shall within y<sup>e</sup> term determined produce for their  
return produce an authentic Certificate of our  
Serjeants. Also shall have remedy according to  
y<sup>e</sup> age aforesaid and shall be further enacted  
by the authority aforesaid that no judgments made  
by any servant during y<sup>e</sup> term of service due by  
former judgments or by determination of the Court  
according to y<sup>e</sup> tenor of this act shall in any wise ob-  
lige any person longer tyme than by his first  
Judgment or determination of y<sup>e</sup> Court shall be limited  
And that this act nor any thing therein contained  
shall be construed to be in prejudice of any person
