act thought at all to fa^vour for the misdoers
it intend^t to p^rovⁱde do pray that it may be enacted
And be it enacted by the Right hon^oble the Lord
Swor^e of and with the advise consent of the
p^riv^ell generall Assembly that from hence forward
all the Actes that shall pass thro^ugh all other
reading Assemblyes shall be from tyme to tyme
fairly transcribed into parchment and by writs
under the great Seals of this Realme sent
to tyme to be passed by the Chancellour for the tyme
then being to the Sheriffs of each respective County
be transmitted & Comand^t to them in the sayd
writs shall be given as well the sayd Actes in
their se^verall & respective Counties in what places
to them shall seeme most convenient to publish and
proclayme as the sayd Actes of Assembly to be
firmly observed & kept. And be it further enacted
that every se^verall & respective County shall from
tyme to tyme pay unto the Chancellour for the
tyme then being for such Transcript of the
lawes & writs under y^e great seals as aforesayd
the summe of two thousand pounds of lawe
