

Discharge to the said Debtors of the said Debts And the
the said Merchants or others could remove the said Hogsheds
tobacco from the said Debtors Tobacco houses, any Sheriff or
other Proved shall come & seize such Hogsheds of tobacco
marked & wayted as aforesaid That then in every such Case
party refuse to make & give to his said Creditors some other full
satisfaction for their said severall debts he shall & may be lawfull
for any two of his Lordships Justices of the Peace of the respective
Counties within this Province upon due proofs made before them
two of the Justices of the said Debt of the said Sheriffs Seizure as
aforesaid, & that the party Debtors refuse to make their Credits &
full satisfaction for their said debts all the Creditors request toward
out Execution with Costs against the body Goods or Chattels of such
Debtors to be executed by the severall Sheriffs for satisfaction of the
said Credits just debts in as full & ample manner as if the said Debt
had been legally recovered by due course of Law And if it shall
happen the said debts soe seized by the Sheriffs shall amount to
more then the Jurisdiction of the County Courts were bound then it
shall & may be lawfull for any one of the Justices of the Provincia
Court at the request of such Creditors to award Execution for such
debts either by capias ad satisfaciendum, fieri facias or Elegit
the Election of the said Creditors) for the recovery of the said debts
as aforesaid Any Lawe Statute or Custome to the contrary notwithstanding
standing Provided that his Lordships Justices doe call before the
both parties & witnesses for due proofs of the justnes of the said
debts, & of the said Sheriffs Seizure as aforesaid, & that as in all
other civile cases in his Lordships Courts the party cast shall satisfy
the Costs & Court Charges and that noe Sheriff within this
Province shall seize or make any persons inhabiting within
this Province their Tobacco houses or tobacco hanging or hanging
or unpart, but only tobacco part in Case for any Rent or
Leavys, nor shall we make any Merchant or others hogsheds
of tobacco received marked or wayted as aforesaid & remaining
in the houses of any person within this Province undisposed of
the Merchant for any cause or thing whatsoever, but only for
Rent Leavys & And any Sheriff soe Seizing or marking any tobacco
houses or Seizing any Hogsheds of tobacco containing more then
what is justly due to his Lordship or Publick for Rent or Leavys
shall pay for every such default the Summe of two Thousand
of tobacco, the one half to the Lord Proprietor the other half to
