

And shall have remedy to the ages afore mentioned  
Further Enacted by the Authority & by with the advice  
aforesaid That no Judgment shall be given by any Court  
of Service due by former Indenture or by Determination  
Court according to the tenor of this Act shall any wages Oblige  
Servant for longer tyme then by his first Indenture or determination  
of the Court shall be limited & appointed provided that this Act in  
anything therein contained shall not give or be construed to give  
any benefit to any Slave whatsoever provided that neither the  
Act nor anything therein contained Repeals or be construed to  
Repeale an Act made at a Gen<sup>l</sup> Assen<sup>y</sup> by the thirteenth day of  
April Anno 1674. Entitled an Act concerning Servants that be  
Bastards And for Encouragment of our Neighbouring Colonies  
Virginia Delaware & the Northern parts of America for the  
taking upp of Servants & others runaways out of this Province  
those parts Bee it further Enacted by the Authority advice & consent  
aforesaid That the Summe of foure hundred pounds of tobacco shall  
from henceforth be allowed & paid to any person in those Colonies  
of Virginia Delaware & the Northern parts of America that  
doe Seize or take upp such Servants or others runaways and  
carry or cause them to be carryed before some Magistrate of any  
County of this Province upon whose Certificate of the delivery of  
person runaways the said Summe of foure hundred pounds of tobacco  
to be raised & Levied out of the publick Assessement & allowed  
to such person for taking upp & delivering to a Magistrate of  
such runaways as aforesaid And the Master Mistis  
Owner of such Servant (if it be a Servant that is for tyme  
reimburst the publick againe the said Summe of foure hundred  
pounds of tobacco upon the delivery of his or her Servant  
Servant to reimburse the Master Mistis Dame & Owner  
Servitude or otherwise to the full Satisfaction & content  
Master Mistis Dame or Owner But if the runaway  
upp & delivered to the Magistrate as aforesaid & affric  
shall runaway to be Imprisoned till such tyme as he  
Satisfaction by reimbursing the publick the said Summe  
hundred pounds of tobacco or shall give good Security  
or shall make Satisfaction by Servitude or otherwise  
that any Servant that runn away out of some  
knoweth such person that takes him upp shall  
hundred pounds of tobacco & noe more This Act  
three yeeres or the end of the next Assen<sup>y</sup>  
shall first happen
