

For the Chancellor, Secretary Judge of Probate of Wills Surveyor Gen.
Sheriffe Coronor & Cuyers of the Courts to Recover the same by way of
Execution against the Goods or body of the person soe refusing & no other
And in case any shall doe contrary directly or indirectly to this Act
shall loose & forfeit to the party grieved treble damages And shall
alsoe forfeit the Summe of Six Thousand pounds of to baits or forty pound
sterl for every tyme he or they shall soe doe the contrary The one
moiety to the Lord Proprietary his heires & Successors the other moiety
to the party or parties that shall sue for the same by any plaint Action
Suit Bill or Informacion wherein noe Escoyne Protection or wayer
of Lawe shall be allowed Provided always that if any shal for any
matter or thing hereafter to be done belonging to their severall Offices
or Offices & by the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Propriety or his Lieut [&] Governour
& Councell, soe allowed & adjudged & not in this Act mentioned by writt
& allowed Then it shall be lawfull to receive such fees as the
Lord Propriety & Councell shall Judge & Allow & noe more under the
penalty aforesaid to be recovered as aforesaid

An Act against Exportation of Corn
Our Neighbour Colony being now Involved in a want, & by that
meanes rendered incapable of tending their Corne seeds, and the
present extraordinary drought threatening a famine, & many people
attending to their owne profit only buying up daily great
quantities of Corne with intent to Export the same by Sea out of this
Province by which we shall be rendered unable to assist our
Neighbours in Virginia to whose preservation we ought in the first
place to attend For prevention therefore of soe great Evils we doe
humbly pray your Lordshipp that it may be Enacted & be intinacted
by the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Propriety with the advice & consent of the
upper & lower houses of this present Gen^l Assembly & the authority
of the same That from & after the twentieth day of this instant
June noe Indian Corne wheate pease Oats or barley be Exported or
Attempted to be Exported out of this Province without leave first
had & obtained of the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Propriety his heires &
Successors or of his or their Lieut [&] or Chief Governour of this Province
for the tyme being under his or their hands & Seales upon paine
& forfeiture of all such Corne soe Attempted to be Transported out
of this Province either by Land or water And if by water of the
Shipps Vessell or boate in which the same shall be Attempted be
Transported with all her Appurcell, tackle & furniture to them
belonging The one halfe thereof to be to the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord
Propriety his heires & Successors & the other halfe to him that shall
Informe Seize or sue for the same in any Court of Record within
this Province by Action of debt bill plaint or Informacion where
noe Escoyne Protection or wayer in Lawe shall be allowed This
Act to endure for One year & noe longer
