

For the Chancellor, Secretary Judge of Probate of Wills Surveyor Gen  
Sheriffes Coroners & Clerks of the Courts to Recover the same by way of  
Execution against the Goods or Body of the person so refusing & no other  
And in case any shall doe contrary directly or indirectly to this Act  
Shall loose & forfeit to the party grieved treble damages And shall  
alsoe forfeit the summe of Six Thousand pounds of tobacco on forty pound  
stand for every tyme he or they shall so do the contrary The one  
moiety to the Lord Proprietary his lieges & Successors the other moiety  
to the party or parties that shall sue for the same by any plaint Action  
Suits Bids or Information wherein now Esayne Protection or waige  
of Lawe shall be allowed provided alwayes that if any shal for any  
matter or thing hereafter to be donee belonging to their several Offices  
or Offices & by the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary his Lieut: Governor  
& Council for a good & Adjudged & not in this Act mentioned by misse  
Allowed Then it shall be lawful to sue & Receive such fees as the  
Lord Proprietary & Council shall judge & allow and more under the  
penalty aforesaid to be recovered as aforesaid —

### An Act against Exportation of Corn —

Our Neighbour Colony being now involved in a warre & by that  
means rendered incapable of tending their Corn fields, and the  
present extraordinary drought threatening a famine, & many People  
attending to their owne profit only buying upp daily great  
quantities of Corn with intent to Export the same by sea out of this  
Province by which we shall be hindered unable to assist our  
Neighbours in Virginia to whose preservation we ought in the first  
place to attend For prevention therefore of so great Evils we doe  
humbly pray your Lordyss that it may be Enacted & be it enacted  
by the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary with the advice & consent of the  
upper & lower houses of this present Genl & Assembly & the authority  
of the same That from & after the twentieth day of this instant  
June next Indian Corn & wheat pease Oats or barley be Exported or  
attempted to be Exported out of this Province without leave first  
had & obtained of the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary his lieges &  
Successors or of his or their Lieut: or Chief: Government of this Province  
for the tyme being under his or their hands & sealed upon paine  
Forfeiture of all such Cornes so attempted to be transported out  
of this Province either by land or water & had if by water of the  
Ship Vessel or boate in which the same shall be attempted to be  
transported with all her Appurtenances tackle & furniture to them  
belonging The one halfe thereof to be to the Right Honble the Lord  
Proprietary his lieges & Successors & the other halfe to him that shall  
Institute Sarc or sue for the same in any Court of Record within  
this Province by Action of debt bill plaint or Information with  
no Esayne protection or waige in Lawe shall be allowed The  
Act to endure for One year & no longer —
