

An Act for Easement of the Inhabitants of this ~
Province in Suits at Law for small debts ~

Whereas the Inhabitants of this Province have been much grieved molested & troubled by being forced by Provinciall Writs to appear at the Provinciall Courts & before Attorneys there, notwithstanding the debts sued for are very small & within the cognizance of the County Courts of this Province, for the preventing whereof for the future the Burgess & Delegates of this present Genl Assembly doe humbly pray that it may be Enacted And be it Enacted by the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary & with the advice & consent of the upper & lower houses of this present General Assembly & the Authority of the same that from & after the publication hereof no action for a booke debt or upon a plaint Bill for or under the summe of fifteen hundred pounds of tobacco & shall be commenced or prosecuted against any Inhabitant of this Province in the Provinciall Courts, except only upon Appeals from the County Courts of this Province And Attorneys of the Provinciall Courts & County Courts for their fees only & costs shall have liberty to sue for the same in the Court where they are Attorneys And that no Attorney of the Provinciall Court shall be allowed any privilege to debarre him from being sued in the County Court where he lives And be it further Enacted by & with the advice & consent aforesaid That if any person shall commence or prosecute any suit or plaint in the Provinciall Court of this Province for or under the summe of fifteen hundred pounds of tobacco & costs in manner & forme as aforesaid shall suffer a Nonsuit & pay such costs to the Defendant as are usually granted by the Provinciall Courts of this Province And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, y^e an account sworn to by the Plaintiff or a bill provided by his Evidence before any one Justice of the Provinciall Court or any two Justices of any County Court within this Province shall be sufficient Evidence to prove the said debts in any County Court within this Province provided also y^e the party who shall swear or give Evidence as aforesaid before one Justice of the Provinciall Court or two Justices of any County Court to prove any debt as aforesaid shall at the same time declare upon his Oath whether he knowes of any payment or discount of any part or parcel of the Acount or debt so to be proved which shall be certified under the hand or hands of such one Justice of the Provinciall Court or two Justices of the County Court before whom the said Acount or debt shall be proved which Certification made & signed as aforesaid shall be taken & received as sufficient
