Stock being killed by them, of which the said Col<sup>d</sup> losses & damages  
this house hath received full satisfaction ~

An Act against the Importation of Convicted  
felons into this Province ~

Forasmuch as severall Masters of Shipp Merchant Sailors  
others have used & still doe use to import into this Province  
severall notorious felons & Malfactors which in severall of  
his Ma<sup>ts</sup> Courts have been convicted of Crimes & felonies as  
aforesaid & afterward procured by Masters of Shipp Merchant  
Sailors & others out of the common Jales to import into this ~  
Province, & sacre to see & dispose of such felons & Malfactors  
as servants to the great prejudice & grievance of the good people  
of this Province, for the preventing whereof for the further the  
Burgesses & Delegates of this present Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly pray that it  
may be Enacted And be it Enacted by the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord  
Prop<sup>rty</sup> by & with the advice & consent of the upper & lower houses  
of this present Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly & the Authority of the same That  
from & after the first day of November next at every Office or  
place where Shipp & Vessells are shal be appointed to be  
entered & cleared, the Clarke of such Office or person appointed  
for the entry & clearing of Shipp & Vessells shall administer  
Oath to every Master of Shipp when he comes to enter that he  
shall declare whether any servant on board his Shipp be ~  
felons Convict as aforesaid And if it shall appear by his Oath  
that they are such, then the said Officer shall take good security of  
the said Master not to sell or suffer the same to be sold quan or  
any other wayes disposed of in this Province, but shall transport  
them & every of them out of this Province before he or his Shipp  
depart out of this Province or in his owne Shipp when the same  
departs this Province And it is further Enacted by & with the  
advice & consent aforesaid That no Master of a Shipp Merchant
