

next adjacent to the house habitation or plantation of the owner of such
tobacco or other goods and the other third part to the Informer or him or them
that shall seize or find for the same whom we have granted protection or wages
of law to be allowed any thing matter or Cause what soever herein or in the afore
said two severall acts before mentioned to the contrary thereof in any wise not
withstanding And it is further enacted that the person or persons so bringing
the tobacco and goods to such port in case the Officer cannot in the sloop
number the hogheads or find out the quantity or quality of such goods wares
and Merchandizes so brought as aforesaid with out taking some part thereof
out, that then for much thereof shall be unladen as will bring the rest
to his sight and view And it is further also enacted that such Officers for
such Entry and Certificate as aforesaid shall receive and have three pence
sterling or three pence of tobacco p hoghead in Cist or the like quantity
in Bulke and also the same rate for other goods wares and Merchandizes
to be paid by the shipper or Exporter of the tobacco goods and Merchandizes
aforesaid and be it further enacted by the Lord Prop^r by and with the advice
and Consent of the Honor and Council of this present generall assembly
and the authority of the same that from and after the last day of August
in the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred Eighty and Eight all and every
person or persons what soever Inhabitants onely or taxables of this Province tra
port and convey to some port or place authorized for a Towne All tobacco and other
Comodities of the growth of this Province intended to be transported (except as
hereafter is excepted) and putt the same into house or houses or stores for
that purpose built or to be built in order to be there sold and from thence to
only shipped offe into other place what soever and further that all and
Every person and or persons ^{what so ever} that shall after the last day of August in
the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred Eighty and Eight shipps of
Export or convey out of this province by any wages or manner what soever any
tobacco or other goods wares or merchandizes of the growth production or manu
facture thereof without having first landed and housed the same in some
port or Towne appointed for trade and taking a Certificate of such landing
and housing under the hand of the Officer of the Towne for the tyme
being shall forfeit and pay forty shillings sterling for every hoghead of tobacco
so shipped off exported or conveyed out of this Province and for the
same rate for a greater or lesse quantity in bulke or for the like
quantity in other goods wares and Merchandizes to be
paid as aforesaid
