And whereas the weighing tobacco and other commodities with ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> hitness of a Court and also not only to the people of this province but to the traders of the same Be it therefore enacted by the authority aforesaid that from and after the first day of August one thousand six hundred eighty and eight no Stillages shall be used for the weighing any tobacco wares or Merchandizes exceeding the weight of one hundred pounds in any of the Townes ports or places authorized for Townes but shall be weighed by weights and scales and to that end the Justices of each respective County Court are here by enjoyned forth with to send for and procure at the charge of each respective County to be assayed in the County heavy substantial scales and lawfull weights weighing upwards of seven hundred pounds weight with three mowable parts to be carried from place to place in the Towne so that the same Justices have the same ready in each respective Towne within each County on or before the said last day of August 1688 and in default thereof the said Justices of each respective County Court shall forfeit and pay for every such weights and scales wanting for each respective Towne in each County the sume of three hundred pounds of tobacco one halfe thereof to the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> and the other halfe thereof to him or them that shall sue for the same in any Court of record within this province and the said weights and scales to be kept by the Officer of each Towne who is to have and receive for each draught thereon weighed the sume of one penny sterling or one pound of tobacco to be payed by them that shall bring the same And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid that no bill plaint information action or suite be brought in any of his Majesties Courts of this Province for or by reason of any breach heretofore committed against any of the aforesaid acts but that all and all manner of breaches thereof be and are hereby released and forgiven And that the Comissioners for Townes now living in each respective County or any five of them in case any Towne or port here by nominated shall ~~not~~ <sup>not</sup> remove from the habitable part of the Comissioners that they cannot convene there and in such case the said Comissioners named in the said first act shall act or any five of them and they by Impeachment be nominated and appointed to be and are hereby appointed to be and are hereby released and forgiven
