An Act for the Encouragement of making Linnen and
 woollen Coath within this Province

The Upper and Lower houses of this present Generall Assembly having
 taken into their serious consideration the great quantities of Linnen &
 woollen Coath which are brought from foreign parts into and spent in
 this Province and that the Inhabitants of this Province for want of the
 like policy and Industry as other Countries have attained unto in the
 Inventing and practicing and putting in exercise the making of Linnen &
 woollen Coath do yearly spend vast sums of money and quantities of
 Tobacco in purchasing those manufactures for Coathing, and considering
 the great benefit and advantage that by the making of such manufactures
 of Linnen and woollen Coath will accrue to this Province, and being
 willing to give all due encouragement that may be, to any person or
 persons whatsoever that will make or cause to be made any Linnen or
 woollen Coath, do humbly pray that it may be enacted and be it
 enacted by the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Prop^{rietary} and with the advice
 and Consent of the Upper and Lower houses of this present Generall
 Assembly
