Creeke where the Town was formerly laid out; and A Town  
to be laid out in Magetty River on y<sup>e</sup> Plantation late  
in y<sup>e</sup> Possession of Thomas Hanson on y<sup>e</sup> South Side of  
the Said River;

In Calvert County at the head of S<sup>t</sup>. Leonards Creeke on  
both Sides of y<sup>e</sup> Mill Branch at y<sup>e</sup> Mouth of y<sup>e</sup> Said Branch  
at y<sup>e</sup> head of Hunting Creeke on both Sides of y<sup>e</sup> Said Creeke  
and in the Freshes of Patuxen River at y<sup>e</sup> Plantation of  
George and Thomas Hardisty;

In Charles County at Port Tobacco & Newport where  
Towns were formerly laid out at Benedict Leonard Town  
in Patuxen River where the Town was formerly Erected;

In Baltimore County at Whetstone Neck in Patapsco  
River upon y<sup>e</sup> Land call'd Hilberry in Bush River and A  
Town in Foster Neck on Gun powder River;

In Somerset County on y<sup>e</sup> North West Side of Wick-  
-ocomico River on y<sup>e</sup> Woodland reach below Danills Flatts  
Creeke, at Rehoboth in Pocomoke River and at Towhill where  
the Towns were formerly Erected, and on a point of Land  
lying on y<sup>e</sup> Forks of Monokin River where Captain Henry  
Smith formerly lived, sometime call'd White House, and  
at Colborns Creek in Annapessee.

In Talbot County at Oxford formerly Erected  
into A Port and Town, and at Doncast in Hy's River  
and at Kingstown in great Choptank.

In Cecil County at Captain Johns Creeke where A Town  
was formerly laid out in Elk River and y<sup>e</sup> Land belonging  
to Paack Calk in Passapatan River;
