

Ordered that the Sheriffs of Dorset County forthwith Summon and
Impress Labourers and Team Carriers to attend y^e P^r Comm^o and assist
them in cutting Stakes & running out y^e P^r Comm^o,

Ordered further that y^e P^r Sheriffs have before the P^r Comm^o on the
Morrow Morning a good Jury of Freeholders Inhabiting in the P^r Land
to Value and appraise the same according to y^e P^r Act of Assembly,

Ordered that y^e Surveyor Rogis Survey Somuch Land upon y^e River
of great Chop Forks and Lowerside of Cambridge Crooks as will include
within the bounds thereof One hundred Acres and that he draw a fair
Platt thereof and have it ready to lay before y^e P^r Comm^o the Morrow
Morning Next.

At which time the P^r Comm^o with the P^r Surveyor Rogis proceed to
Run out y^e P^r one hundred Acres of Land as followeth Viz One hund
Acres of Land Situate Lying and being on y^e South Side of great Chop
Fork River and on y^e West Side of a Crook Called Cambridge Crook
Beginning at a Post Numbered Sixty Seven standing at y^e North Side
of a Cove being the Southernmost border of a Lot of y^e P^r Number and
running from y^e P^r Post North Sixty five degrees Easterly Nineteen
perches down the Crook bounded therewith to a Cove from thence
North Sixty Degrees Westerly thirteon perches up y^e Cove from
thence North Sixty Degrees Easterly fourteen perches from thence
North Down y^e Crook bounded therewith North Eighty Degrees
Westerly Eleven perches and from thence North Cross y^e Cove Eight
perches and from thence down y^e Cove North Sixty five Degrees
Easterly Nine perches from thence North forty seven Degrees
Easterly twenty five perches down the P^r Crook bounded therewith
from thence still down y^e Crook bounded therewith South Eighty

Degrees East twenty perches from thence still down y^e Cambridge
Crook bounded therewith North twenty five Degrees Easterly sixteen
perches to great Chop Forks River Side and from thence North ten
Degrees Westerly down the P^r River Side bounded therewith
Sixty six perches from thence still down the P^r River North forty
Degrees Westerly fifteen perches to y^e Marsh of a small Crook from
thence South forty five Degrees Westerly into y^e Wade one hundred
Sixty perches from thence South thirty Degrees East Sixty six
perches from thence South thirty Degrees East Sixty perches to a
doop branch from thence South forty Eight Degrees East down y^e Branch
to y^e a Cross Cambridge Crook and from thence North Sixty Eight Degrees
Westerly down the said Crook North fifteen Degrees Easterly Seven
perches from thence still down y^e P^r Crook bounded therewith
