much as it is Objected that John Coments of Talbot

therefore Ordered that the Clerks of Towns give Notice to  
the P<sup>r</sup> Coments that if he doth not appear at Cambridge at  
the Next Court Court to be held the first Tuesday of Sep: Next  
before the Comm<sup>rs</sup> and make his Claim appear the Comm<sup>rs</sup> will  
take the P<sup>r</sup> Motion in to further Consideration —

Ordered by y<sup>e</sup> Comm<sup>rs</sup> of Towns that the Town of Armitage  
hundred be Laid out the twentieth of this Instant Aug and  
y<sup>e</sup> Coll<sup>r</sup> Enalls the Surveyor thereon present moor Accordingly  
and that y<sup>e</sup> Clarke shall Venue to the Sheriff to be there with a Jury  
Then Came J<sup>r</sup> James before y<sup>e</sup> P<sup>r</sup> Justice & made appear before them y<sup>e</sup> he Came &  
actually Resided and dwelt in y<sup>e</sup> Town of Virginia y<sup>e</sup> fourteenth day of Feb: last  
wh: he prays may be Entred for y<sup>e</sup> he Intends to Come if Benefit of Donization
