Act, or paid or tendered the Rate or price of y^e said Lot as y^e Act
Requires, neither doth it appear to y^e Com^r. by any plat that
any such Towne was laid out;

And for As much, as y^e Jury on Enquiry who was Owner of y^e
S^r. Lands did upon their Oath say that J^r. Kirke was Owner of
all the S^r. Lands, and took no notice of y^e S^r. Com^r.s or other
persons from whom he derived his Right It was therefore ad-
judged, that y^e S^r. Com^r. had no Right nor Title to y^e S^r.
Lot of Land, and that the same notwithstanding his pretensions is free
to be taken up by any person who will improve the same; where-
upon it is further Ordered that Col^l. Enalls have y^e same Lot to wit
No. 15 at y^e Towne of Cam Bridge he Complying with y^e Act of Assembly
Then y^e Com^r. Adjourned to y^e Court house at Cambridge to the
first Tuesday of November next.
