 of this province, And also that they and every of them shall and may
 be enabled to maintaine prosecute Avow Justice and defend off
 all manner of Actions suits plead plaints and other Demands
 whatsoever as Liberally, frankly, freely, fully, lawfully and surely
 as if they and every of them had been Naturall born People, and Subjects
 of this province, any Law, Statute Usage or Custome to the contrary
 in any wise notwithstanding

An act to Invest two tracts of Land in Richard
 Bennett Esquire late the land of John Howel Deceased

WHEREAS Richard Bennett of Talbot County Esquire, hath
 by his petition set forth, to this present Generall Assembly, that, he
 having formerly had Letters of Administration, granted him by
 the Gen^l of Generall, of this province, Authorizing him, to
 Administer, all and singular, the goods, Chattells and Credits of
 certain John Howel late of Rockton in Great Britain Mariner
 Deceased And that by Verue of the said Letters of Administration
 the said Richard granted as aforesaid took upon him the administration of
 all and singular
