Released and for Ever quit claimed all the right, whiche the said Susannah  
or ought to have to the said Remaining part of the said Land unsold as aforesaid to the  
James Keatly his heires and assignes, and for that the said Judenture, or deed  
release being executed by the said Susannah wife under Coverture, will not  
the said Thomas Tracy nor the heires of the said Susanna from having and paying  
the said Lands and premises, the humbly petitioned this generall Assembly that  
might be Enacted: And be it Enacted by the Queenes most Excellent  
Majestie by and with the advice and Councell of her maie, President, Counsell, and  
Assembly of this province and the authority of the same, that the said Judenture  
or deed of release, Enrolled in the County Court records of Amherstvile Hall  
according to the purport, true intent and meaning thereof to have and take  
Effect, and be as good and Available in Law, to all Judgements, Constructions, and  
purposes as if the same Thomas Tracy had joyned in the said deed, with the  
said Susannah in the Legall Execution thereof, as good as if hee in seeing  
as the said Thomas and Susanna could have made them, Notwithstanding  
the said Susannah being under Coverture both made, and Executed the said deed  
in her own name only, And shall not Culy for ever barre the said Susanna  
her heires and assignes, but also the said Thomas Tracy, and all payment  
from by or under him, from all and Every the Land in the said Release  
Expressed or mentioned, or intended to be there Expressd or mentioned,  
And all the Rents, Issues and proffitts of the same, any Law Statute or Sease  
or Custome or Coverture of the said Susanna to the contrary notwithstanding.  
And be it also enacted by the authority, advise and Councell  
that the said four thousand pounds of lobace paid or to be paid to the  
Susannah by the said James Keatly, shall not be Liable to any attaint or  
other process whatsoever for or upon account of any debt, due, or owing from  
the said Thomas Tracy, but shall wholly be to the use and benefit of the  
said Susanna towards the reowing and supporting her and her children  
any Law Statute or Custome to the contrary notwithstanding.
