In An Act for settling and vesting an estate of inheritance in fee simple of land one hundred and fifty acres of land lying in Calvert County on 40^m Hickman of Calvert County Esq; her son and heir of William Hickman deceased and by the said William the father purchased of from a certain Thomas Hinton -

Whereas William Hickman late of Calvert County planter deceased on about the nineteenth day of July anno Domini one thousand five hundred and fifty six purchased of and from a certain Thomas Hinton of the said County deceased his half part of a piece of Land lying in the said County of Calvert called the old Plantation being part of a tract of Land called 5^m Hounds and actually paid the purchase money for the same, which said Thomas Hinton the above mentioned day of July anno Domini one thousand and six hundred ninety five by his certain bond or writing obliging himself and his heirs to convey and assure the same by good & sufficient Conveyance and Assurances in Law unto the said Wm Hickman deceased or his heirs or assigns to begin at the bay on the south side of a stream called the brook the whole length into the wood - And whereas the said Wm Hickman and the said Hinton are both dead, the said Land never Conveyed or assured to the said Hickman according to the tenor of the said bond and no persons lost to represent the said Hinton but an infant of about four years of age incapable of making any conveyance or assurance of the said Land. And the said Wm Hickman son & heir of the said Wm Hickman deceased having petitioned this present General Assembly that the same purchase might be confirmed to him by an act of this General Assembly and having made appear to this present General Assembly truth of the said allegations. And the Guardian of the said infant having had due notice to appear before this General Assembly to make his Objections ag^t the same, if to him it should seem meet & no objection being made thereto - It is therefore prayed that it may be enacted under & by the Queen most Excellent Mary by and with the advice and Consent of the President Council and Assembly of this Province and the authority of the same that the said Wm Hickman the son shall be and is hereby authorized and impowered to cause the said bond or writing obligator to be entered on the records of Calvert County Court and by virtue of such recording of the aforesaid bond or writing obligator and of this act, a good sure and indefeasable estate of inheritance of land to the said half part of the said piece or parcel of Land called the old Plantation, shall stand hereby vested and settled in the said Wm Hickman, his son and his heirs and assigns for ever, in as full and ample manner, to all intents and purposes, as if the same had been actually Conveyed and Assured by deed, or deeds, or conveyance, or Conveyances duly executed by the said Thomas Hinton deceased or his heirs, saving to the right of the said Wm Hickman deceased
