

President Council and Assembly of this province and the authority of the same

 same, and to appropriate so much of the money or tobacco arising by such sale
 to his own use as will satisfy the said sum of two hundred and thirty one pounds
 and the residue to the Maintenance and Support of the said Tobias his wife
 Children And that any such purchaser or purchasers by virtue of any Sale
 to be made by the said Robert Roberts and this Act, shall, have, hold,
 possess and enjoy the said Land and every part and parcel thereof to
 him or them, his or their heirs and Assigns for ever, in a good sure and
 Indefeazable Estate of Inheritance in fee simple any Law Statute or Usage to
 the contrary or other defect whatsoever notwithstanding

An Act for the Relief of Tobias Pollard
 and John Pollard of Dorchester County
 Gentlemen.

Whereas Tobias Pollard second Son of John Pollard late of
 Dorchester County deceased, and John Pollard, Grandson and heir at Law
 to the said John Pollard Esquire have petitioned this General Assembly
 shewing that the said John Pollard Esquire by his last will & Testament
 had devised, to a certain William Pollard deceased father of the Petitioner
 John Pollard several tracts of Land viz^t. Grass, Reed In, Hamersmills
 Patricks Wells and Williams Goodwill and to the said Tobias Pollard divers
 other tracts of Land videlicet Marsh Land heargt. out. Lett. Marps desire
 Bivood poynt, Johns Desire, The race, Island in the Marsh, Wolf Tragg
 Ridge, Goliou, and good Luck Point, And the heirs Male of their
 bodies Lawfully begotten, All which tracts of Land lying and being
 in Dorchester County of the Children of the said Tobias and John Pollard
 being Daughters are not Capable of Inheritance by reason of the
 specialty of the said Tobias and John Pollard therefore humbly
 pray
