

39 Determination shall be final and without any further Review  
unless such Judgment shall exceed ye sum of Three Hundred pounds  
sterling or Sixty Thousand pounds of Tobacco then and in every such  
Case ye party against whom such Judgment shall be given may  
appeale to ye Queen and Council in England

And be it further Enacted by ye Authority Above and  
Consent aforesaid That all Appeals or writts of Error already made and  
brought or hereafter to be made ~~or~~ brought before ye Governour  
and Council shall and may be heard by ye Governour and Council  
out of Assembly time, Any Thing in ye same writt Any other former  
Law or statute to ye contrary notwithstanding And for that it  
may soe happen that ye Governour of this province for ye time  
being may hereafter be concerned in an Appeals made or writt of  
Error brought from ye Judgment of ye provinciall Court to ye  
Governour and Council and or he otherwise indisposed or absent

Be it therefore Enacted by ye Authority Above and  
Consent aforesaid That it shall and may be sufficient in every such  
Case for ye Council only to hear and determine such matters of  
Controversy, whereof ye first of ye Council in Commission being there  
present shall provide whose Judgment thereupon shall be definitive  
(Except before Excepted) in the full and ample manner as if ye said  
Governour were then actually present and providing Any thing in  
in this Act to ye contrary notwithstanding

ye punishing ye Offences of Fornication and Adultery It is amongst  
other things therein Enacted That whosoever should directly or  
indirectly Entertain provide for or Cause to be Entertaind or provided  
for any Lewd woman or women or that should frequent her or them
