of ye Age of fifteen Yearred or above shall be allowed Expended
Except Clergy Men and likewise such poor persons as receive Alms
from ye County, and also all such Taxes as shall be adjudged
by ye County Courts to be past Labour who are heroby Exempted
From Taxes

Whereas Edward Vautour deceased in ye Kingdom
of Great Brittain Knight by his Petition to this Great Generall
Assembly hath sett forth, that he sometime since entrusted Edward
Vautour late of Am. Arundell County decessed with a considerable
quantity of Goods to be disposed of for ye proper Amount of him ye
said Thomas Johnson and Company of ~~Everpool~~ ^{Everpool} Merchants, And that
ye said Edward Vautour not having rendered them ye said Amount
he was obliged to and making use of and converting ye Goods
and Money thereby arising to his own use, May ye said Thomas
Johnson and Company implored a certaine Certified Copy of Am. Arundell
Esq^r Ad their Agent to call ye said Vautour to Account who obtained
Judgmt. against him in ye Provinciall Court to satisfy which said
Copy ye said Edward Vautour ye fiftenth Day of June Anno Dom
One Thousand seven hundred and nine made a Deed of Bargaine
and Sale to ye said J^r Thomas Johnson by ye Name of Thomas
Johnson of ~~Everpool~~ ^{Everpool} Esq^r And for ye Consideration of Sixty three
pounds Eight Shillings the same sold and conveyed to ye said J^r
Thomas Johnson and his Heires forever, a certaine Part of Land
lying in ye Woods in Baltimore County called Timber Cove
containing five hundred Acres and there Executed ye same Deed
with a Letter or Consent of Attorney directed to William Bladen
Esq^r or any other Attorney of ye Provinciall Court in powering him or
them to acknowledge ye aforesaid Deed according to ye Law of this
province, But instead of acknowledging ye aforesaid Deed before ye
provinciall Court or some of ye Justices thereof ye aforesaid Deed by
some Justices was Recorded in Am. Arundell County Court without
