Thomas Johnson shall for ever be old good valid and Effectual in Law to all Intent and purposes whatsoever as if ye same had been by ye said Edward Vaux in this life time legally acknowledged and Recorded in ye provinciall Court or County Court of Baltimore County And that ye said J. Thomas Johnson by virtue of ye said conveyance and of this Act shall have hold and Enjoy to him and his Heires for ever old good an Estate in Fee Simple of in and to ye said Land in ye said conveyance mentioned as he could or ought to have had, if ye said deed or conveyance had been legally acknowledged by ye said Edward Vaux in this life time, the benefit of ye Acknowledgment thereof according to ye said Warrant or Letter of Attorney or ye due and legal Recording thereof or any Law Use or Custome to ye contrary notwithstanding

An Act for the naturalization of Samuel Guichard of An-
Arundell County planter

Be it Enacted by ye Queen most Excellent Majesty by and with ye Advice & Consent of her Majtys privy Councill & Assembly of this Province and ye Authority of ye same that Samuel Guichard of An Arundell County planter be in all things adjudged taken & reputed to have hold and Governed as her Majtys natural born Subject of this Province, and that he by ye Authority aforesaid be Enabled and Adjudged to all Intent and purposes to demand Challenge & shew hold and Enjoy any Lands Tenements Rents and Hereditaments to which he might be in any wise Entitled as if he had been her Majtys free and natural born Subject of this Province and also that he be Enabled to maintain
