Sate with pistolls and woodstord shergents belonging his coat
called Sen Ewe and a Lam One good Bed & furniture to him ye
said John Turle his Vicar and assigner for ever his heire and a
Boare to him ye ^{sa} John Turle to him his Vicar for ever, Hem to
my son Twenty Turle I give and Bequeath One Part or partell
of Land lying in vicine George Family containing five hundred
Acres lying at ye head of Quittawoutan Creek called Combs
to him ye ^{sa} Twenty Turle and ye Vicar of his body lawfully
begotten for ever And on failure of such Vicar to ye right Vicar
of me ye ^{sa} John Turle for ever ad also to ye ^{sa} Twenty Turle
I give and Bequeath four Negroes namety Sambo Tom White Inoll
with their future Increase And also five cow and Calves with their
Eight Ewe and Lambes with them ^{sa} a Tow and a Boare, One
Silver flaggon marked R H One good Bed & furniture to him ye
said Twenty Turle his Vicar and assigner Hem to my son Charter
I give and Bequeath a Part of Land in Charter Family called
Linnell hill containing three hundred Acres together with One
other partell of Land adjacent to ye same containing Eighty
three Acres together with One other partell of Land adjacent to
ye other two called Turle discovery containing fifty Acres ad also
One other partell of Land adjacent to ye other called Barnd hill
containing One hundred and fifty Acres ad also One other partell
of Land adjoining to ye ^{sa} Barnd hill given me by my Father
John Turle containing fifty Acres ye ^{sa} overall partell of Land
aforesaid to ye ^{sa} Charter Turle and his Vicar of his body
lawfully begotten for ever And on failure of such Vicar to ye
