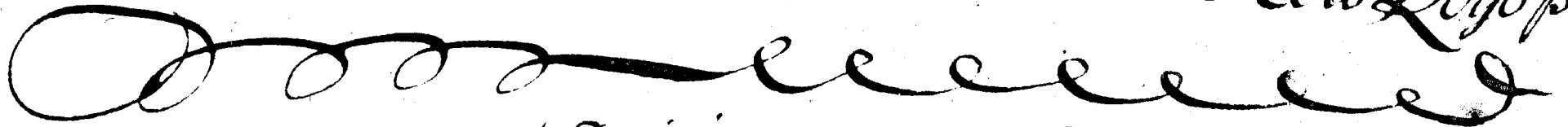

Be it Enacted by ye Queen most Excellent Majesty by and
with ye Advice and Consent of her Maj:ty's privy Counsell and
Assembly of this Province and ye Authority of ye same that ye
