 which they or any of them might by any Lawfull way Entitled be if they
 and every of them had been her Majestys free and naturall born
 Subjects and free people of this province And alsoe that they and
 every of them be Enabled to maintain prosecute & recover Justly and
 defend all manner of wrongs Sutes pleas plaints and other demands
 whatsoever As liberally frankly freely fully Lawfully and
 securely As if they and every of them had been her Majestys
 naturall born Subjects and free people of this province Any
 Law Statute Usage or Custome to ye contrary in any wise notwithstanding

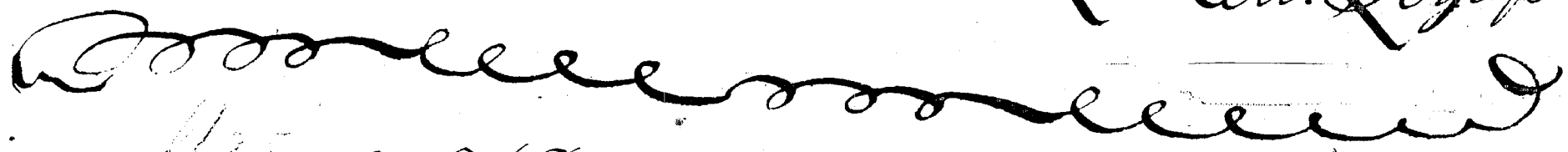

An Act Receiving an Act of Assembly of this province
 Entituled an Act for Encouragement of Tillage & Reliefe
 of poor Debtors
 Be it Enacted by ye Queens most Excellent Majesty by with ye Advice
 and Consent of her Majestys privy Councill and Assembly of this province
 and ye Authority of ye same That ye above mentioned Act Entituled an
 Act for Encouragement of Tillage and Reliefe of poor Debtors made at
 a Session of Assembly begun and hold at ye Court of Annapolis ye fifth
 day of September Anno Dom: Seventeen Hundred and fowr be Lawfully
 hereby Revived & Continued in full force and strength from and after
 this present Session of Assembly for & during Three yeares and to ye
 End of ye next Session of Assembly which shall first happen after ye
 End of ye said Three yeares
 Provided that ye said Act or any thing therein Contained shall not
 be Adjudged to extend to ye payment of any protested Bills of Exchange
 that have been or shall be drawn by any person whatsoever upon any person
 or persons in great Brittain or elsewhere out of this province to
 ye same payable to whomsoever
