been formerly Subject to great and manifest inconveniences by
pressing of horses under pretence of Carrying and Conveying publick
Letters and pamphlets for prevention whereof and that due care may
be taken for the future that all publick Letters and pamphlets
relating to her majesty or the publick Service of this province be
securely and expeditiously Conveyed according to these directions
the delegates of this present General Assembly do pray that it may be

Excellent maistress by and with the advice and Consent of her maiestys
greatest Council and Assembly of this province and the authority
of the same, that the Sheriff of each respective County is hereby charged
and did Commanded to take Care of all publick Letters and paishets

to the Sheriff or Under-sheriff of the next adjacent County, and for the
Encouragement of the several and respective Sheriffs and their diligence
in Conveying such publick letters and paishets that they may be
allowed the several sums hereafter expressed to be laid in the
