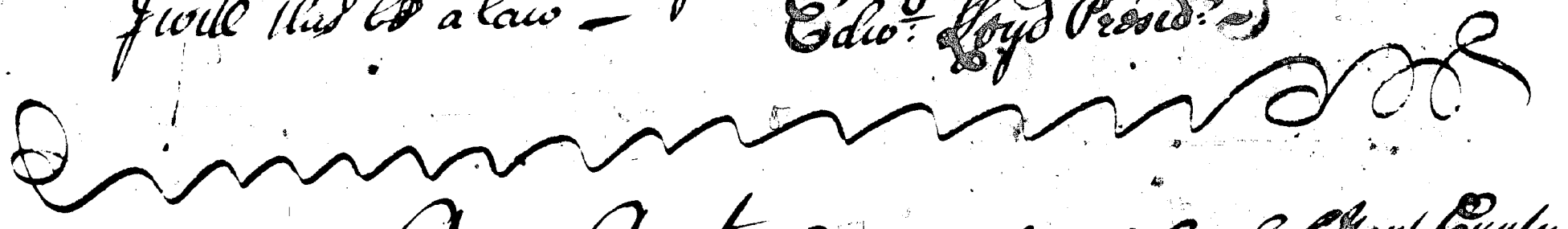

Be it Enacted by the authority aforesaid and Court of that
 if any person or persons shall pack any such tobacco in Casks or otherwise
 by it self without packing it with good tobacco with designe of deceit &
 shall before sayd or payment away of such tobacco deliver to the party
 purchasing or receiving such tobacco the nature and quality thereof
 they shall not incur the penalty before in this act imposed on
 such as false pack tobacco any thing in this act to the contrary
 notwithstanding &c.

An Act for relief of Josiah Couch of Kent County
 in Confirming a certaine Sale of Land from Wm Couch to him
 and his heirs &c.

W^h th Josiah Couch of Kent County & William Couch
 late of Annapurnde County were seized in fee as tenants in Common
 of a Certain tract or parcell of Land called Meldon lying on the East
 Side of Chesapeake Bay next adjoining to the Land of Jonathan Cowdry
 Containing two hundred acres, And whereas on or about the eighth day
 of October Anno Dom^o Seventeen hundred and Six It was agreed by all
 between the said W^m Couch and the said Josiah Couch that the said W^m
 Couch upon payment made to him by the said Josiah of the Sum of
 thirty Seven pounds shoud make over his moiety being the one
 half of the said parcell of Land called Meldon to the said Josiah his heirs
 or Assignes to the true performace of which agreem^t the said W^m by his
 bond under his hand and Seal bearing date the same eighth day of
 October in the year seventeen hundred and Six did bound himself his
 heirs Execut^r and adm^r to the said Josiah in the penall sum of seventy
 four pounds Sterling And forasmuch as the said Josiah Couch has
 (made)
