

 and undoubted Succession in the true protestant line appor-
 tain — and of Right belong to your most Excellent Majestie
 and that you are and of right ought to be by the Law of your
 Realm of great Brittain our most Gracious Sovereigne —
 Kinge and George by the grace of God of great Brittain
 France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c and
 to whose princely person & progeny your Successors in the proto-
 testant line as by Law established the Royall Estate (crown
 and Dignity of the said Realme and Dominion) will all
 all honours Titles Royalltye prerogative power Juris-
 diction and Authoritie to the same belonging are most
 fully lawfully and Intirely Inherited and Incorporated United
 and forever annexed — And there unto we make humbly
 and faithfully do submit and oblige ourselues to you and
 posteritys forever until the last drop of our Blood be spent
 and do beseech your Majestie to accept herof as the first
 fruits in this Generall Assembly of our Loyalty & Fidelite
 to your Majestie and your Royall progeny forever — — —
