Be it Enacted by the Kings most Excellent Majesty by and with  
the advice and Consent of his majestys Governour Council and Assembly of this  
province and the authority of y<sup>e</sup> same that Thomas Harvey of Calvert County  
Frenchman and his Children by and in all things adjudged taken reputed had  
held and Governed as his Majestys Naturall borne Subjects of this province  
and that they and every of them by the authority afo<sup>e</sup> be Enabled and adjudged  
to all Intents and purposes to Demand Challenge have and Enjoy any Lands  
Tenements and hereditaments to which they or any of them might in  
any wise be Intitled to within this province as if they and every of  
them had been his Majestys free and Naturall borne Subjects and like  
people thereof and also that they and every of them be Enabled to main-  
tain prosecute avow Justifie and defend all and all manner of actions  
Sutes pleas complaints and other demands whatsoever within province and  
Liberally Frankly and freely Fully Lawfully and Securely as  
if they and every of them had been his Majestys Naturall borne  
Subjects and like people thereof any Law Statute usage or Custom  
to the contrary in any wise Notwithstanding \* \* \* \* \*  
May the 26<sup>th</sup> 1715 Read and assented to by his Majesty's Council  
in the house of Delegates and signed per order to by his Majesty's Council  
The Maenemara etc. D<sup>n</sup> signed for W. Bladen's Council  
June the 3<sup>rd</sup> 1715 In the Behalfe of his most Sacred Majesty King George
